## Recycling Checklist and Guide

### Recyclable and Non Recyclable Materials



PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE RECYCLABLES OUTSIDE THE BLUE BINS.

DO NOT PUT ANY GLASS IN THE BINS.

#### ACCEPTED

- TELEPHONE DIRECTORIES
- FROZEN FOOD BOXES (unwaxed)
- CORRUGATED BOXES (shipping boxes...)
- FOLDING CARDBOARD (cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg crates...)
- CATALOGUES AND MAGAZINES
- FLYERS AND ADVERTISING INSERTS
- ENVELOPES (with or without window)
- NEWSPAPERS
- BOOKS
- SHREDDED PAPER (placed in small, clear and tied plastic bags)
- BROWN PAPER AND BAGS
- WRITING, OFFICE AND PRINTING PAPER



#### NOT ACCEPTED

- WRAPPINGS MADE OUT OF DIFFERENT MATERIALS (Pringles chip cans, pet food bags...)
- FABRIC SOFTENER SHEETS
- CARBON PAPER
- WRAPPING PAPER AND RIBBONS
- PAPER TOWELS AND FACIAL TISSUES
- WAXED PAPER OR CARDBOARD
- PHOTO PAPER
- ALL SOILED MATERIALS (pizza boxes, diapers, cat litter...)
- VEGETATION (twigs, leaves, lawn clippings...)



#### ACCEPTED

- PLASTICS #1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 7
- ALUMINUM ITEMS (clean foil and pans)
- TIN CANS (no need to remove label)
- JUICE BOXES (without straw)
- CANS AND PLASTIC BOTTLES (beer, pop, water, juice)
- METAL SAUCEPANS
- FOOD CONTAINERS (ice cream, margarine, yogurt...)
- MILK CONTAINERS (plastic and cartons)
- HOUSEHOLD CLEANING PRODUCT CONTAINERS (liquid bleach, soap...)
- PERSONAL HYGIENE PRODUCT CONTAINERS (hand cream, shampoo...)
- METAL LIDS



#### NOT ACCEPTED

- PLASTICS #6 (number in recycling loop)
- PLASTIC BOTTLE CAPS (without any recycling loop)
- BINDERS
- CELLOPHANE OR PLASTIC WRAPS
- PLASTIC HANGERS
- PRESSURIZED CONTAINERS
- CHOCOLATE AND GRANOLA BAR WRAPPERS
- CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS (wood, insulation fiber, siding...)
- OBJECTS MADE OUT OF RIGID PLASTIC (lawn chair...)
- HAZARDOUS WASTE (aerosol cans, light bulbs, oil, paint, batteries...)
- BAGS IN CEREAL BOXES
- POTATO CHIP BAGS
- PLASTIC OR BIODEGRADABLE BAGS
- STYROFOAM (food trays, plates, cups...)
- POOL COVERS
- TOOTHPASTE AND COSMETIC TUBES
- PLASTIC UTENSILS
- GLASS (refundables, food jars, Pyrex...)



**PREPARATION STEPS:**

- Sort your recyclables at home to make it easier at the blue bins.
- Flatten all boxes before dropping in the recycling bin.
- Remove lids and caps.
- Rinse all soiled containers and dry well.
